Entrematic Begins New Commercial Product-Numbering System


As of Sept. 14, Entrematic began transitioning to a new product-numbering system for all Amarr commercial products, assigning a more logical series of four-digit numbers to indicate specific features of the product.

For commercial sectional doors, the first two digits represent the gauge/material (e.g., 24 = 24 gauge), the third digit indicates the type of insulation (e.g., 1 = polystyrene with vinyl backing, 4 = polyurethane), and the fourth digit shows the thickness (e.g., 1 = 1-3/8", 3 = 3"). For example, product number 2742 is a 27-gauge steel door with polyurethane insulation and is 2" thick.

Entrematic is also updating the product numbers for Amarr commercial rolling sheet and rolling steel doors. Commercial dealers can download a list of new product numbers at amarrdealer.com. www.entrematic.com ■






