

Swiss Army Knife Doubles as GDO Remote

In January at the Consumer Electronics show in Las Vegas, Victorinox unveiled the Victorinox Remote, a Swiss Army Knife that also serves as a remote control for a garage door opener.

The technology inside the Victorinox Remote learns the high-frequency transmitter signal of post-1996 garage door openers. With the touch of a button on the knife, the garage door can be opened and closed.

A second button allows the remote to learn the signal of a second device, such as another garage door opener, lights, and other electronic home products. The product is expected to be available in mid 2010.

Chamberlain to Preview New Commercial Operators at Expo

In April at Expo 2010, Chamberlain will preview its full line of LiftMaster commercial operators that are compliant with the new UL325-2010 standard. At Expo, Chamberlain plans to display its new UL-compliant LiftMaster Logic 4.0 operators and Medium Duty Logic operators with the new CPS-U and CPS-UN4 (NEMA 4) photosensors.

A key requirement of the new UL325 standard is a continuously monitored primary entrapment protection safety system. Manufacturers must comply with the new standard by Aug. 29, 2010, in order to bear the UL mark.

The newest addition to the commercial operator line is the Timer Light Status Card (TLSCARD), a plug-in option board exclusive to Logic 4.0. The card enables control of auxiliary devices such as warning lights, bells, horns, and strobes. It also provides an adjustable pre-warning timer that operates with the timer-to-close feature. www.chamberlain.com ■

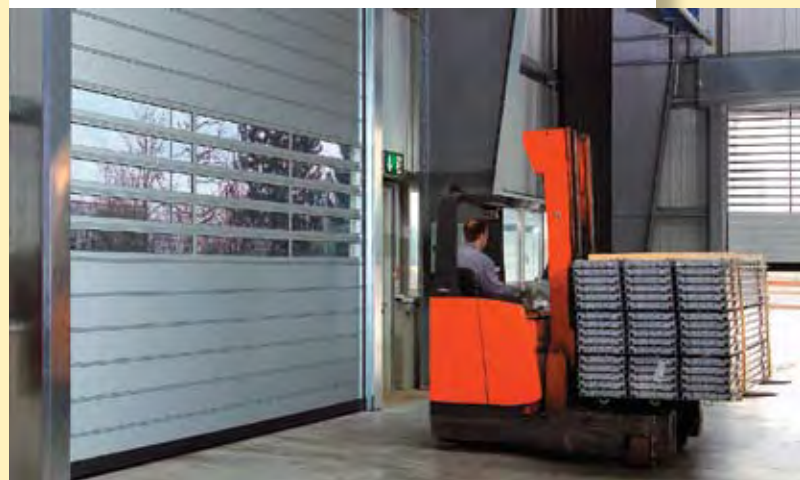

Sommer Opener Selected in Top 15 at IBS

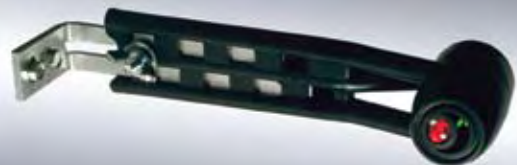

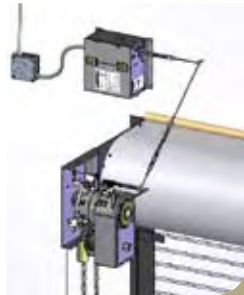
Lawrence Introduces Fire Door Release

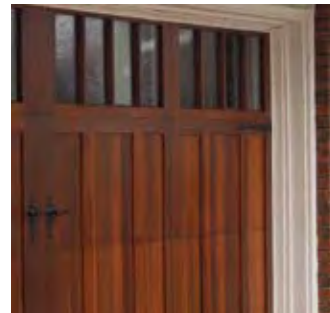
