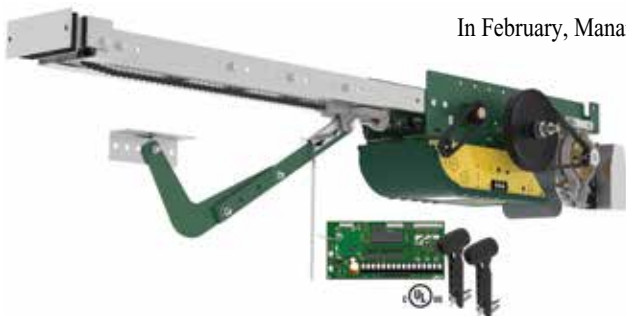


Manaras-Opera Launches Low-Noise Trolley Operators

In February, Manaras-Opera launched the Silencio line of low-noise apartment-style trolley operators.

A light curtain is built into low-profile guide tracks, which eliminates the use of coil cords and photo eyes. For use on interior or exterior door openings, the door is always interior mounted. In February, EMX introduced the new IRB-MON, a type B1 non-contact sensor for use with automatic doors, gates, and barriers. The new sensor, designed to meet the upcoming 2016 UL 325 regulation, provides a universal solution for entrapment protection.

The IRB-MON is suitable for use with monitored output (a pulse or heartbeat frequency signals the device is operational and not obstructed) and non-monitored output provided by form C relays.

A 115' operating range and a simple 2-wire connection and potentiometer for sensitivity adjustment provide easy setup. Its waterproof NEMA 4X enclosure will stand up to the elements, and its lens-less design decreases fogging and false triggering.

In February, Cornell and Cookson announced that Cornell's Thermiser Max and Cookson's Temp-Master insulated rolling doors comply with the prescriptive air infiltration requirements of ASHRAE 90.1-2013, the IECC 2012, and the California Energy Code.

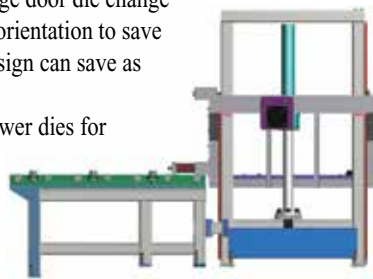
By incorporating a combination of sealing, insulated curtains, and thermally broken guides, the design meets air infiltration requirements of less than 0.3 cfm/ft². Air infiltration is reduced by 94 percent compared to that of a standard rolling door.

Bradbury Manufactures B.O.S.S. Flying Shear with Slitter



In November, Bradbury announced its new B.O.S.S. Flying Shear with Slitter. The shear runs up to 250' per minute and is capable of producing 5 slits of .048" prepainted steel, .050" aluminum, and .037" stainless steel.

It has servo acceleration and closed loop controls for +/- 1/16" length tolerance at any speed. A hand wheel with a digital counter is used to engage and disengage the slitter. 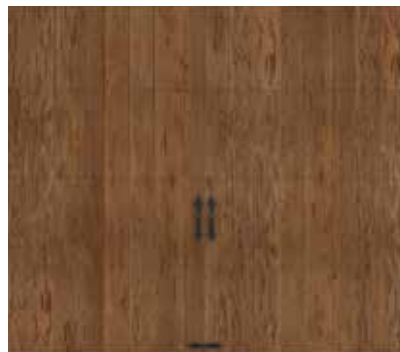
