Part 2 Overview of IDEA and ACI

The door and access systems industry has recognized the benefits of certification and accreditation programs for decades. The industry is fortunate to have two certification bodies that provide programs for industry participants: the Institute of Door Dealer Education and Accreditation (IDEA) and Accreditation Certification Institute (ACI).

Both are independent and non-profit organizations that provide programs for companies and individuals involved in the sale, installation, and service of industry-related products.

Generally, IDEA and ACI address different audiences; however, there are some overlaps in the area of automated gate systems. DASMA is involved with both ACI and IDEA and supports the missions and activities of both organizations.

About IDEA

IDEA was the first of the two organizations to be established, formed in 1996 through the collaborative efforts of DASMA and IDA. These sponsoring organizations recognized a need for more focused education of industry professionals as well as a means of verifying the knowledge, skills, and abilities of those professionals, and thus supported the

development of the certification programs.

DASMA and IDA provided seed money over a period of several years, and they continue to support IDEA today in a variety of ways. They also regularly appoint representatives to serve on the IDEA board of directors, with both associations having equal representation on the board.

IDEA provides educational programs, certification programs, and training materials, in the form of study guides. All of the programs and materials provided by IDEA are related to the door and access systems industry. The following certification or accreditation programs are offered through IDEA:

- Automated Gate Systems Designer
- Automated Gate Operator Installer
- Certified Door Dealer Consultant
- Commercial Rolling Door Systems Technician
- Commercial Sectional Door Systems Technician
- Door Dealer Accreditation Residential Installer
- Rolling Steel Fire Door Technician

IDEA testing dates are scheduled throughout the year and during the IDAExpo 2022 event on Tuesday, April 5, and Wednesday, April 6. For more information about IDEA and future exam dates, visit www.dooreducation.com.

About ACI

ACI is a relatively new certification body, formed in 2019. ACI provides certification and accreditation

programs for the fence, gate, active vehicular access barrier, access control, deck, and rail industries.

ACI's supporting organizational members, AFA, DASMA, NOMMA, and the Chain Link Fence Manufacturers Institute (CLFMI) each appoint one representative to the board of directors that governs the organization.

AFA provided seed money for ACI during its formative stage, and the other organizational members provide additional support, including industry expertise and oversight.

ACI currently provides the following programs:

- Certified Fence Contractor
- Certified Gate Automation Designer
- Certified Gate Automation Technician

Several additional programs related to fences are in varying stages of development.

ACI and its programs are being developed in accordance with the ISO 17024 standard. Accreditation to the ISO 17024 standard (see the previous article in this series for more information about accredited certification programs) restricts some activity. Perhaps of most relevance is the inability to "grandfather" in certificants who carry credentials from another certifying body. ■
