New BBB and housing numbers for the door industry

2023 statistics remain consistent

BBB: COMPLAINTS

+3%

For the second consecutive year, complaints filed to the Better Business Bureau (BBB) in the U.S. and Canada against "Garage Door Repair" companies increased. The number of complaints increased from 320 in 2021 to 331 in 2022.

While the number of "Garage Door Repair" complaints is still trending in the wrong direction, a 3% increase is a far cry from the 39% increase the industry saw from 2020 to 2021.

Complaints filed against "Garage Doors" in 2022 jumped from 496 to 609 — a notable 19% increase. From 2020 to 2022, "Garage Doors" complaints saw a combined increase of 44%.

was the complaint ranking for "Garage Door Repair" in 2022 out of 6,134 total business categories. The 2022 ranking was a minimal increase from the 487 ranking in 2021. The "Garage Doors" ranking also rose slightly, moving up to 313 from 335 a year ago.

Overall complaints to all business categories (not just door-related categories) increased by 4% in 2022. The total number of complaints filed to the BBB has seen a consistent increase over the past five years.

BBB: INQUIRIES

The number of consumer inquiries to the BBB about "Garage Door Repair" companies increased in 2022 from 101,611 to 103,020 — a marginal 1% increase from the previous year. "Garage Door" in which is increased by 20% from 200,067 in 2001 to

inquiries increased by 3% from 303,067 in 2021 to 311,067 in 2022.




While BBB complaints overall increased, total BBB inquiries for all business categories dropped 19% from the previous year.


Don't be fooled: While the total number of inquiries for all business categories dipped, the percentage of garage door related inquiries ("Garage Door" and "Garage Door Repair" combined) increased.

25%

of all BBB inquiries in 2022 were garage door-related inquiries (compared to 21% in 2021).


Lesson: You would be wise to pay attention to your BBB rating and resolve any complaints promptly. It appears that the garage door industry continues to be in the spotlight, being a large percentage (25% to be exact) of overall BBB inquiries.




NEW HOUSING STATISTICS 1,022,000

is the number of new single-family houses that were completed in 2022. That's a 5%


increase from the number of houses built in 2021, and that number more than doubles the 483,000 total from a decade ago. After hitting a peak of 1,654,000 houses in 2006, the numbers bottomed out at 447,000 in 2011 and have been gradually recovering ever since.

THREE-CAR (OR MORE) GARAGES




