

DASMA attends Washington state HFC meeting

In November, the Permanent Rule addressing hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs) was addressed during a Washington State Department of Ecology meeting. The Permanent Rule, designated as Chapter 173-443 WAC, Hydrofluorocarbons, affects insulated products.

DASMA technical director Joe Hetzel attended the meeting. According to Hetzel, the Permanent Rule specifies that door manufacturers conducting business in Washington state must:

- 1) Notify the state of Washington by Dec. 31, 2019, if you are a door manufacturer that offers insulated products that contain HFCs.
- 2) Notify the state once these offerings have been transitioned to HFC-free products on or before April 29, 2020.
- 3) Stay current on the latest developments and updates involving the Permanent Rule. The Permanent Rule is scheduled to take effect in November 2020.
