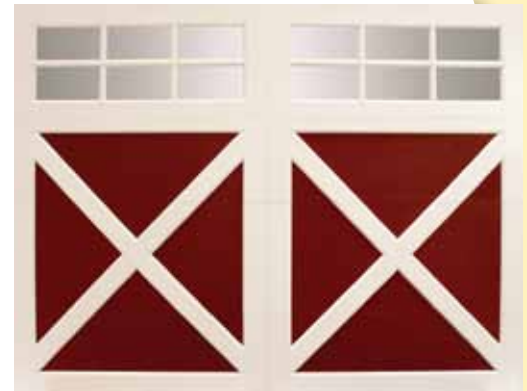


Raynor Updates RockCreeke Line

Schweiss Offers Remote-Operated Battery Backup

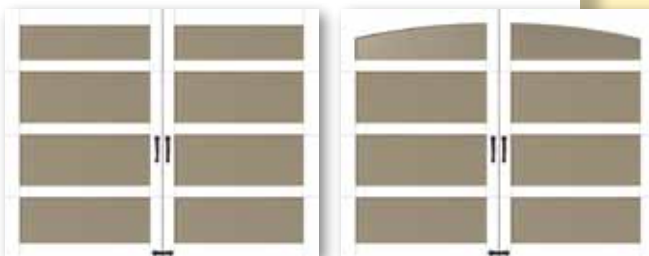

Wayne Dalton Adds New Color, Four New Designs

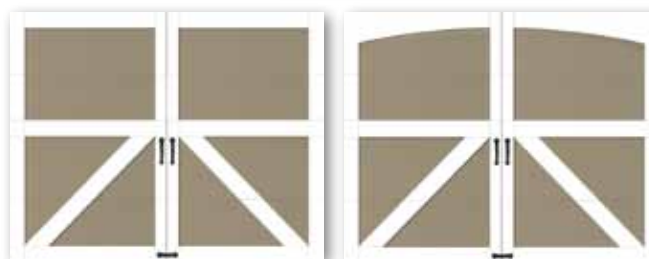
In October, Wayne Dalton announced four new designs and a new black color option for its Model 6600 steel carriage house garage door.
